



Patient rights, privacy, and choice are being trampled.

Consumers have experienced lost choices, deceptive practices, and diminished privacy since the merger of CVS and pharmacy benefit manager Caremark:

- **Patient records** are used to target non-CVS customers at home and push them to fill their prescriptions at CVS stores.
- **Patients are being told** they must fill maintenance medications at a CVS — or pay a higher co-payment at their current pharmacy.
- **Patients are confused** by Caremark literature, which implies their benefit can only be used at CVS.
