

NCPA FOUNDATION PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

The NCPA Foundation is pleased to announce that the "Presidential Scholarship" program will be continued during the 2004-2005 academic year. All pharmacy students who are student members of NCPA are eligible to apply for a \$2,000 scholarship for the 2004-2005 academic year. The student must be enrolled in an accredited U.S. school or college of pharmacy on a full-time basis during the 2004 fall term and the 2005 spring term.

Children of NCPA Foundation Officers, NCPA Officers, or NCPA Executive Committee members are not eligible to participate in the program.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Each applicant must complete an NCPA Foundation Scholarship Application Form. In addition, the student must provide the following materials with the completed application:

1. A copy of the most recent transcript of his or her college grades.
2. A letter from a school official familiar with the student's activities. This letter should briefly describe the student's extracurricular accomplishments, leadership qualities and contributions to the school.
3. A letter from a pharmacy owner or manager, preferably an NCPA member. This letter should briefly describe the student's extracurricular accomplishments, leadership qualities and contributions to the profession of pharmacy.
4. A letter from the applicant to the NCPA Foundation Presidential Awards Committee outlining his or her school and citizenship accomplishments and objectives for the future.
5. A résumé or curriculum vitae describing the student's work and professional experience.
6. Please list **ALL** past awards or scholarships you have received, and their monetary value.

Please Note: Students may only receive this award one time

AWARD CRITERIA

All awards will be made on the basis of the following priorities:

LEADERSHIP QUALITIES -- Potential candidates will be evaluated by the NCPA Foundation Presidential Awards Committee on the basis of leadership qualities and accomplishments, as well as involvement in extracurricular activities. These qualities will be measured by the required supporting documents.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT – Scholastic success is a necessary condition for consideration of the award and will be measured using current college transcripts.

All application forms and supporting documents must be **POSTMARKED** by:

March 1, 2004

This award is made on an individual basis and is non-transferable. The recipient will receive a check from the NCPA Foundation for \$2,000 during the 2004 NCPA Annual Convention in Boston, MA, October 10, 2004. **NOTE: The award recipient must be present at the NCPA Annual Convention to receive this award.**

Transfer from one accredited school or college of pharmacy to another is permitted, provided the academic standards of the previous institution have been met at the time of transfer.
